Coronavirus: Entering Switzerland

Sanitary measures such as an entry form, a negative test or quarantine may be necessary for entry into Switzerland by air, rail, road or boat from an area or state with an increased risk. These requirements are subject to change. Please ensure you know what the latest requirements are before setting off. Information may also be found here: www.bag.admin.ch/einreise

Notice for foreign nationals: It is possible that you are not allowed to enter Switzerland. You will find information on the website of the State Secretariat for Migration SEM at sem.admin.ch/risk-countries. The overview of health-related measures at the border does not tell you whether or not you are allowed to enter.

Testing – RT PCR or rapid antigen

If you want to be tested during your stay, we recommend the following addresses:

Opening hours: daily 4 am to 10 pm,

Two test centres:

Landside Centre Check-in 2, Floor 1 (no flight ticket or boarding pass required) and Airside Centre, D Gates, next to the Transit Hotel (flight ticket or boarding pass required)
→ No appointment necessary, online registration with Fast Track Service possible
→ Test results: PCR test 5-6 hours, Antigen 15-20 minutes by email
